father bergen's sunday homilies is a three volume collection of reflections on the sunday scripture readings for each week of the liturgical year years a b and c in sunday homilies liturgical year b fr william bergen sj brings together more than forty years of preaching experience to offer thoughtful scripture based reflections for every sunday and major feast each homily follows the lectionary readings for the seasons of advent christmas lent easter and ordinary time year b centers on the gospel of mark complemented by passages from john emphasizing the immediacy of faith the call to discipleship and the healing power of christ this volume invites readers to encounter the word of god with renewed understanding and devotion whether for personal reflection or preaching inspiration william bergen sj is a native of new york city and has been a jesuit priest for the past sixty years he has spent most of that time in parish ministry first at saint ignatius parish in baltimore and then for the past thirty five years at st ignatius loyola parish in new york city fr bergen had been on the staff of mount manresa retreat house in staten island prior to its closing and an adjunct professor of theology at st peter's college in jersey city nj since his retirement at the end of 2024 he has continued to pursue his interest in sacred scripture and christian spirituality
